Travel for sailing organised by an MYA club:	Only within local authority area and can go up to five miles into another local authority. Overnights not allowed. Maintain 2m social distancing. Participants aged 18 years or over can travel to and from a Level 0, 1 and 2 area to take part in organised sport, physical activity, training and competition. They should not travel to a Level 3 or 4 area.		
Informal MYA club activity:	Informal activity for exercise. Field of play bubble can be applied for all ages. Maintain 2m social distancing.	No Indoor gatherings. 6 people / 3 households outdoor gatherings / groups, 4 / 2 indoor gatherings / groups in public places.	4 people / 2 households can socialise indoors (private home or public place) 6 / 3 outdoors	8 / 3 Outdoors. 6 / 3 indoors in a home or public place.	Maximum 15 people from up to 5 households. (15 / 5 outdoors TBC)
Organised MYA boating activities:	Only informal sailing for club members within the local authority area. Field of play bubble can be applied for all ages. Maintain 2m social distancing.	Field of play bubble can be applied for all ages. Maintain 2m social distancing.	Club, inter-club and District activities. All ages. The number of people in an outdoor sporting 'field of play bubble' including coaches, officials and other support staff at any one time is to be confirmed. Maintain 2m social distancing.
