**1. Event Schedule :**

REGISTRATION :- The following shall be presented to the Race Committee before 09. 30hrs on the event day.

Competitors name, boats sail number and club name.

Emergency contact details (MYA Contact Form preferred)

SUNDAY 11<sup>th</sup> of AUGUST      Briefing approximately 09.45

RACING will commence not less than 15 minutes after Briefing. No race will start after 1600 hrs any race in progress at 1630 hrs will be abandoned.

PRIZE GIVING – will take place as soon as possible after the conclusion of the final race.

**2. Location: D.M.B.C, SHAUGH LAKE. Near CADOVER BRIDGE, DARTMOOR. DEVON. For precise location details see website [dartmoormbc.org](http://dartmoormbc.org)**

**3. Entry and Eligibility**

Entry is open to all members of MYA affiliated Clubs and to members of foreign clubs affiliated to a Delegated National Member of IRSA. Preferably enter directly on-line via the MYA Racing Calendar. Go to <https://mya-uk.co.uk/events> then find the relevant event. Alternatively, e-mail or post your entry to STEVE WATTS at the address given below. The final closing date for receipt of entries is:- WEDNESDAY 7<sup>th</sup> AUGUST .

**4.Entry Fees - Event entry fee is £5.00 payable on the day at Registration**



**5. Sailing Instructions** – This event will be run under the current version of the Racing Rules of Sailing and the MYA SSI's. The Race Officer reserves the right to use Observers drawn from the competitors.

**6. Entry list, Sail Numbers and Frequency Allocation:** – Permitted frequencies are 27mhz, 40mhz and 2.4ghz. For frequency bands other than 2.4ghz, a minimum of five (5) frequencies shall be stated on the entry form and be available at the event.

**ENTRY LIST – SAIL NUMBERS:** will be found on the club website (when/if practical) and will also be displayed on the official event notice board.

**7. Accommodation** – See club website and local tourist information.

**8. Parking** - as the club is a member's only site there is no restriction on parking which is free within the site area for competitors/visitors. Please note however the following – there is limited car parking available near to the lake on the North side access point. If parking cars elsewhere, please make sure you leave access room for emergency vehicles. At busy times the Old Wheel flat area will become the main car park. **MOTOR HOMES/CARAVANS** – ALL vehicles of this type must park at the Old wheel flat area. Dispensation has been granted by our landlords (SIBELCO UK) for motor home/caravan parking overnight (Saturday) providing that NO grey or black water is discharged on site.

**9. Refreshments** – Due to the location competitors are advised to bring their own refreshments for the day. Emergency bottled water will be on site and the club at its own discretion may provide refreshments during the prize giving.

**10. Competitors with disability** – Competitors that require any form of help or special requirements should, prior to entry, get in touch with the club contact given in section 12 to check if the Club is able to help with the provision of any such special requirement. The onus is on the competitor to establish whether the available facilities are adequate before deciding to enter the event.

**11. Disclaimer of liability** – All those entering or taking part in this event do so at their own risk and responsibility. The Model Yachting Association, the organising authority, the host Club and any other parties involved in the organisation of this event disclaim any and every responsibility for loss, damage injury or inconvenience that might occur to persons and goods both ashore or on the water as a consequence of entering or participating in the event covered by this Notice of Race. At all times the responsibility for the safety of their boat and themselves plus the decision to participate or continue must rest with the competitor.



**12. General Info** – Information for competitors can be found on the club website. In addition to this please be aware that you will be accessing an old industrial site so drive slowly and wear suitable clothing as Dartmoor's weather can be changeable. Stout footwear is essential due to the nature of the ground generally, but the lake is walkable fully on two sides and platformed on the north side. Launching will be from two platforms and the club reserves the right to insist on assisted launching in rough weather. Recovery of disabled boats will be by dinghy only as the lake sides are not accessible to competitors push off poles will be available.
